Electronics Day rules!!!

You may bring ONLY **ONE** of the following things:

- an electronic device **OR**
- a favourite toy

There will be 1½ hours to play with them in the Middle and Senior Syndicates and 1 hour in the Juniors. For the rest of the day the devices and all toys will be stored in a safe place in your classroom.

Any electronic devices or remote control toys are to be no bigger than an iPad.

All electronics must be in a plastic bag or case to protect them

Students **MUST** follow the Bellevue School E-Learning and Digital Citizenship Student Use Agreement when using their personal devices at school

You **MUST** get your parents' permission beforehand to bring any of the items mentioned. The school will not be responsible for any missing or broken items.

Bring a Gold Coin donation as koha for bringing one of the items mentioned above to use on the day.

Participation in this day is optional.

Remote control toys that can be used outside are allowed. The use of these will be supervised. They will not be used if it is raining.

No charging at school. Bring your devices to school fully charged! (Battery packs are allowed).

Trading cards will not be allowed.

There will be wireless access for electronic devices.
