## WELLINGTON TO MOVE TO ALERT LEVEL 2 AS OF 12.59PM ON TUESDAY NIGHT - SCHOOL OPEN AS OF THURSDAY 9 SEPTEMBER

Kia ora Bellevue Whānau,

Just a brief update in light of the government's announcement this afternoon that Wellington will move to Alert Level 2 as of midnight tomorrow (Tuesday). More detailed information will follow with tomorrow's 'Distance Learning communication' as usual.

In order to give our team time to prepare to welcome back their students and work within the Level 2 Health requirements, **Bellevue School will be open for all students from Thursday 9th September.**

### What to expect for the rest of this week -

#### Tuesday - Level 3

- Most students learning from home
- 'Bubble school' in operation on Bellevue site as it has been - no change for Essential Worker families
- Distance Learning operates as usual with online check ins 9-10am and 2-3pm, Google Meets, etc
- Hard copy packs with Distance Learning for 8-14 September come home as usual for those who have requested them

#### Wednesday - Level 2

- Most students learning from home
- 'Bubble school' in operation on Bellevue site as it has been - no change for Essential Worker families
- **No staff online for the rest of the week** for check ins, Google Meets etc as they will be working onsite preparing for the return of the children, settling them in and focusing on a positive start back at school

#### Thursday and Friday - Level 2

- All students welcomed back onsite (unless they are unwell or self isolating)
- School focus is on student wellbeing - settling back in safely, connecting with one another, sharing experiences/learning, having fun
- Operating under Alert Level 2 Health requirements - see below for a 'snapshot'

- No distance Learning provided - though we will be establishing where this is required for any families self isolating
- **More information will come home about school at Alert Level 2 tomorrow**

## School Open - Students Only

- Students are expected to attend school unless they are unwell or awaiting a COVID-19 test result.
- Students who have high risk health conditions are encouraged to take additional precautions.
- Parents/Caregivers/Whānau do not enter the school grounds.
- If you need to collect your child for an appointment or because they are unwell, ring the office when you arrive at the school gate.
- If staff notice your child is unwell you will be contacted to collect them from school.
- All adults on site need to contact trace by signing both the register and scanning the school's QR Code.
- There are no student Road Patrollers. Parent volunteers assist students to cross Bancroft Terrace.
- School pick-ups are staggered to allow physical distancing.
- Some school events may be postponed or cancelled.
