



YEAR SIX CAMP INFORMATION

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

This is an advance notice to tell you about the Year Six Camp at the end of the year and for you to indicate if your child will be attending, if you would like to attend camp as a parent helper and if you would like to help with fundraising.

You will notice that camp is from the Tuesday to the Friday. The major content of the camp will remain the same as last year with children participating in all of the organised activities. At school on Monday we will participate in team building activities as a syndicate before going on Camp (Year 6) or EOTC activities (Year 5)

Where: Forest Lakes Camp, Otaki

When: Tuesday 1 December – Friday 4 December 2015

Cost: \$210 – Please note that this is a provisional cost and may change.

At this stage we need three things from you as parents and caregivers. Firstly, in order to finalise the budget we need to know exactly how many students will be going. Please indicate on the slip on the following page as to whether your child will be attending or not and have it returned to school by **Friday April 10.**

We would like all children to attend camp. If they don't go they will be missing out on a fantastic opportunity to challenge themselves in a different environment. If you have any concerns please contact us by e-mail or we are happy to meet with you to discuss any issues for you or your child. Also, please bear in mind that if cost is an issue don't hesitate to contact one of us as soon as possible so we can make some arrangements. If you would like to begin paying for camp now please feel free to do so. You are more than welcome to pay the cost off in instalments.

Secondly, as the cost for the camp is a large amount many of you may find it useful to participate in selling chocolate to fundraise towards the cost of camp. We will need one or two parents who are willing to organise and oversee the entire chocolate selling fundraising. This involves ordering the chocolates online, distributing to the students and the collection and counting of money. You will need to be available regularly at 3pm to hand out new boxes of chocolate to the children. Teachers are unable to do this.

Finally, it would be great to hear from parents/caregivers who are able to stay during the whole week and help with supervision of activities. There will be no cost to you. If you are able to come on camp with us, please also indicate on the return slip and we will send the application packs home to you.
